Criminal barrister Jeffrey Lamb's most notable cases include:

R. v. Bone (Lewes CC) A large scale fraud involving many investors seeking to invest in a revolutionary NHS software package

R. v. Orhon (Kingston CC) Two attempted Murders and 2 s.18 woundings when a man randomly attacked four women in a supermarket car park.

R. v. Chambers & Others (Guildford CC) Three men defrauded a pensioner of £300,000 by doing work on her house which was not required. The Co-defendants were alleged money laundered of that money.

R. v. Barnett (Old Bailey CC) A 19 year old youth kicked and stamped a pensioner to death.
